

# Aoyama Garbage Collection Schedule

2024  
April to September

For the separation and disposal of garbage, see the attached sheet or the Iga City Garbage Separation App.

## Proper disposal of garbage

- [1] For general business waste produced by a shop, office or factory, commission an operator licensed to collect and handle the general waste in Iga City (Aoyama Branch Office) or bring it in yourself.
- [2] Separate garbage properly and put it out in the designated place, on the designated day, and at the designated time (before 8:30 am). \*Unseparated garbage will not be collected.
- [3] Garbage cannot be brought in on public holidays or weekends (except 3rd Sun every month)

Burnable trash	Put in an Iga Nambu Environmental Hygiene Association garbage bag designated for the Aoyama District of Iga City (blue semitransparent bag). *Since the designated garbage bags were changed on October 1, 2014, the former green bags cannot be used.
Non-burnable trash	Put in a semitransparent bag (45ℓ or smaller), not a transparent or black bag, and write "㊦" on the bag with a marker pen. (There is a charge for bringing this waste to the waste facility yourself.) The former green bags cannot be used.
Plastic containers/packaging	Put in a semitransparent bag (45ℓ or smaller), not a transparent or black bag. The former green bags cannot be used.
Small electric appliances	Put in a semitransparent bag (45ℓ or smaller), not a transparent or black bag. The former green bags cannot be used.

## Garbage that cannot be collected or processed

- ©Computers, motorized bicycles, gas cylinders, items containing chemicals such as agrochemicals, agricultural materials, insecticides, etc., tires, batteries, fire extinguishers, drum cans, waste oil (machine oil, fuel), industrial waste, infectious waste. (Contact the shop where you purchased the item or other dealer and ask them to collect the waste.)
- ©There are other things that cannot be processed, such as earth, sand, concrete, etc. Please contact us for details.
