




	<p>Food scraps (leftover food, vegetable skins, etc.), used tea leaves, shells, paper diapers, cotton work gloves, waste pieces from cutting cloth, strings (Cut to under 50cm in length.), dirty paper, photos, aluminum foil, etc.</p>  <p>※Never dispose of metals, etc. with burnable garbage. ※Please drain the liquid from food scraps well before disposing of them.</p> <p><b>Dispose of in the designated Iga City garbage bags.</b></p>	<p><b>Hard-plastic items</b> CDs, plastic buckets, wash-basins, plastic hangers, etc.</p> <p><b>Leather/vinyl items</b> Shoes, bags, rubber hoses, etc.</p> <p><b>Bedding, carpets</b> Floor cushions, curtains, blankets, bed pads/mattress protectors, floor mats, etc. ※Fold and bind with string.</p> <p><b>Other</b> Trimmed branches, wood pieces, dirty styrofoam box, etc. ※Remove metal parts. ※Make sure that all items are shorter than 50cm. ※Dispose of items other than bedding, blankets, carpets and trimmed branches in garbage bags.</p> <p><b>Dispose of at each area's designated collection site.</b></p>	<p><b>Cups, packs, trays</b></p>  <p><b>Plastic bags, kitchen wrap</b></p>  <p><b>Caps, nets, cushioning materials</b> Plastic nets to pack fruits or vegetables. Styrofoam for cushioning. ※If the item is difficult to clean, deposit items with "burnable garbage".</p> <p><b>Plastic bottles</b> ※If the item is difficult to clean, deposit items with "hard-plastic/leather items".</p> <p>※Always dispose of in garbage bags.</p>	<p><b>Paper</b> Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, paper cartons, etc. Separate by type and bind with string.</p>  <p>※When disposing of shredded paper, always double-bag.</p> <p><b>Cloth</b> Clothes, sheets, towels, etc. ※Blankets should be put out on the same day as "hard-plastic/leather items".</p>  <p>※For cloth, dispose of in garbage bags.</p>	<p><b>Beverage bottles</b> Juice bottles, alcoholic beverage bottles, etc. ※Return "returnable" bottles to the store you purchased them from.</p> <p><b>Food/drink bottles</b> Instant coffee bottles, jam bottles, etc.</p> <p><b>Seasoning bottles</b> Soy sauce bottles, salt bottles, etc. ※Dispose of broken glass bottles etc. as "landfill waste".</p> <p>※Separate into colorless transparent bottles and colored bottles, and directly put in collection containers. (These can only be filled up to two-thirds of their capacity.)</p> <p>※Remove caps and rinse.</p>	<p><b>Small electrical appliances</b> Irons, vacuum bottles, hair dryer, rice cookers, electric heaters, radio cassette recorders, etc. ※Always remove batteries.</p> <p><b>Kitchen knives, scissors</b> Put into cans or wrap in thick paper and indicate they are "キケン"(KIKEN:dangerous).</p> <p><b>Metal items</b> Pots, frying pans, etc.</p> <p><b>Other</b> Umbrellas, electric cords, steel cans, electric blankets, etc.</p> <p>※Dispose of items other than umbrellas and plant supports in garbage bags.</p>	<p><b>Beverage bottles</b> Tea bottles, soda bottles, alcoholic beverage bottles, etc.</p>  <p><b>Specified seasoning bottles</b> Soy sauce bottles, mirin or sweet sake bottles, etc.</p> <p>※Do not put in bags, etc. but directly put in collection nets at collection sites. (The net can only be filled up to two-thirds of its capacity.)</p> <p>※Remove caps and labels, and rinse out the bottle.</p>	<p><b>Beverage cans</b> Soda cans, alcoholic beverage cans, tea cans, etc.</p>  <p>※Even though a can is made of aluminum, if it is not a beverage can, it should be separated as "Metal".</p> <p>※Rinse and always dispose of in garbage bags. Do not crush cans before disposal.</p> 	<p><b>Vegetable cooking oil</b> Salad oil, olive oil, sesame oil, etc.</p>  <p>※Remove impurities.</p> <p><b>Dispose of in collection containers at each area's designated collection site.</b></p>	<p><b>Hazardous products</b> Gas cartridges for table top cookers, spray cans, lighters, etc. ※These items must be emptied. ※Always dispose of in garbage bags.</p> <p><b>Tapes</b> Video tapes, cassette tapes, etc. ※Cassette or video tapes should not be disassembled, and they should be put in garbage bags as-is.</p> <p><b>Glass, ceramics, dry batteries</b> Ceramics, glass products, dry batteries, bulbs, etc.</p>  <p><b>Other</b> Disposable pocket body warmers, broken bottles, etc. ※Put directly in collection containers. (These can only be filled up to two-thirds of their capacity.)</p>

Taking to a disposal plant	Type of garbage	Disposal plant / TEL	Fee (per disposal)	Service hours / holiday break	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>★For all types of garbage other than burnable, please use transparent or white, semi-transparent bags of 45 liters or less.</li> <li>★Disposal of garbage from business activities (including agricultural business) is the responsibility of the business owner. 【These items should not be disposed of at collection sites.】</li> <li>★Have items such as construction and demolition waste, tires, batteries, automobile parts, fire extinguishers and motorcycles disposed of by the stores you purchased them from or by waste disposal companies. 【These items are not collected by the city.】</li> <li>★Dispose of refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes driers, air conditioners and TV sets according to the Home Appliance Recycling Law. 【Inquiries about home appliance recycling】 Home Appliance Recycling Ticket Center TEL: 0120-319640</li> <li>◎Please make sure to dispose of garbage <b>by 7:30 am</b> on the appointed collection days at the designated collection sites. 【Separate garbage at the site according to the garbage separation rules】</li> </ul>
