City Council

The City Council comprises 24 members (quorum: 24) selected by citizens. It determines the operations of the city and budgets that are proposed by the local government and incorporates the views and requests of citizens into the city operations. It aims to become a council open to citizens by publishing activity information on a regular basis and broadcasting debates in the council meetings.
