<p>Food scraps (leftover food, vegetable skins, etc.), used tea leaves, shells, paper diapers, cotton work gloves, waste pieces from cutting cloth, strings (Cut to under 50cm in length.), dirty paper, photos, aluminum foil, etc.</p> <p>※Never dispose of metals, etc. with burnable garbage. ※If possible, dispose of food scraps at home. (If this is impossible, please drain it well before putting in with burnable garbage.)</p> <p>Dispose of in the designated Iga City garbage bags.</p>		<p>Hard-plastic items CDs, plastic buckets, wash-basins, plastic hangers, etc.</p> <p>Leather/vinyl items Shoes, bags, rubber hoses, etc.</p> <p>Bedding, carpets Floor cushions, curtains, blankets, mats, etc. ※Fold and bind with string.</p> <p>Other Trimmed branches, wood pieces, dirty styrofoam box, etc. ※Remove metal parts. ※Make sure that all items are shorter than 50cm. ※Dispose of items other than bedding, blankets, carpets and trimmed branches in garbage bags.</p>	<p>Cups, packs, trays</p> <p>Plastic bags, kitchen wrap</p> <p>Caps, nets, cushioning materials Plastic nets to pack fruits or vegetables.
