	<p>Food scraps (leftover food, vegetable skins, etc.), used tea leaves, shells, paper diapers, cotton work gloves, waste pieces from cutting cloth, strings (Cut to under 50cm in length.), dirty paper, photos, aluminum foil, etc.</p>  <p>※Never dispose of metals, etc. with burnable garbage. ※Please drain the liquid from food scraps well before disposing of them. ※Please limit grass, fallen leaves, and similar items to four bags per collection point.</p> <p>Dispose of in the designated Iga City garbage bags.</p>		<p>※Remove metal parts. ※Make sure that all items are shorter than 50cm. ※Dispose of items other than bedding, blankets, carpets and trimmed branches in garbage bags.</p> <p>Hard-plastic items CDs, plastic buckets, wash-basins, plastic tanks, plastic hangers, etc.</p> <p>Leather/vinyl items Shoes, bags, rubber hoses, etc.</p> <p>Bedding, carpets Floor cushions, curtains, blankets, bed pads/mattress protectors, floor mats, etc. ※Fold and bind with string.</p> <p>Other Trimmed branches, wood pieces, dirty styrofoam box, etc.</p>		<p>※Always dispose of in garbage bags.</p> <p>Cups, packs, trays</p> <p>Plastic bags, kitchen wrap</p> <p>Caps, nets, cushioning materials Plastic nets to pack fruits or vegetables. ※If the item is difficult to clean, deposit items with "burnable garbage".</p> <p>Plastic bottles ※If the item is difficult to clean, deposit items with "hard-plastic/leather items".</p>		<p>Paper Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, paper cartons, etc. Separate by type and bind with string.</p> <p>※When disposing of shredded paper, always double-bag.</p> <p>Cloth ※For cloth, dispose of in garbage bags.</p> <p>Clothes, sheets, towels, etc. ※Dispose of blankets and soiled items as "hard-plastic/leather items".</p>	<p>※Separate into colorless transparent bottles and colored bottles, and directly put in collection containers. (These can only be filled up to two-thirds of their capacity.) ※Remove caps and rinse. ※Dispose of cosmetics bottles, broken glass bottles etc. as "landfill waste".</p> <p>Beverage bottles Juice bottles, alcoholic beverage bottles, etc. ※Return "returnable" bottles to the store you purchased them from.</p> <p>Food/drink bottles Instant coffee bottles, jam bottles, etc.</p> <p>Seasoning bottles Soy sauce bottles, salt bottles, etc.</p>	<p>※To prevent fires, please use the "Small Appliance Recycling Box" for mobile batteries and lithium-ion battery products. ※Dispose of in plastic bags.</p> <p>Small electrical appliances LED products, electric heaters, audio equipment, etc. ※Always remove batteries.</p> <p>Kitchen knives, scissors Put into cans or wrap in thick paper and indicate they are "キケン"(KIKEN:dangerous).</p> <p>Metal items Pots, frying pans, etc.</p> <p>Other Umbrellas, electric cords, steel cans, electric blankets, etc. ※Dispose of umbrellas and other rod-shaped items tied together.</p>	<p>※Put in collection containers. (These can only be filled up to two-thirds of their capacity.) ※Put in bags if full and place next to collection containers. ※Remove caps and labels, and rinse out the bottle.</p> <p>Beverage bottles Tea bottles, soda bottles, alcoholic beverage bottles, etc.</p> <p>Specified seasoning bottles Soy sauce bottles, mirin or sweet sake bottles, etc.</p>	<p>※Dispose of aluminum cans that are not beverage cans as "Metals". ※Rinse and always dispose of in garbage bags. Do not crush cans before disposal.</p> <p>Beverage cans Soda cans, alcoholic beverage cans, tea cans, etc.</p>	<p>※Dispose of in designated collection containers (pail cans).</p> <p>Vegetable cooking oil Salad oil, olive oil, sesame oil, etc.</p> <p>※Remove impurities.</p>	<p>※Put as-is in collection containers. (These can only be filled up to two-thirds of their capacity.)</p> <p>Glass, ceramics, dry batteries Glassware, heat-resistant/hardened glass bottles, heavily stained glass bottles, pottery, dry batteries, bulbs, disposable pocket body warmers, etc.</p> <p>※Do not put directly in collection containers; always dispose of in garbage bags and place next to collection containers separated by Hazardous products and Tapes.</p> <p>Hazardous products Gas cartridges for table top cookers, spray cans, lighters, etc. ※These items must be emptied.</p> <p>Tapes Video tapes, cassette tapes, etc. ※These should not be disassembled, and they should be put in garbage bags as-is.</p>

* For all types of garbage other than burnable, please use transparent or white, semi-transparent bags of 45 liters or less.

* Small Electrical Devices Recycling Bins are available at the Iga City Hall, Sakura Recycling Center, all branch offices, and all district community centers. (Excluding Ueno/Iga Branch Office and Kawai/Yamada District Community Centers.)

* Swollen mobile batteries are accepted at the Sakura Recycling Center office.

※ Items that cannot be processed at Sakura Recycling Center

- Disposal of garbage from business activities (including agricultural business) is the responsibility of the business owner. [Examples of business activities] Garbage generated at summer festivals organized by neighborhood associations, agricultural waste excluding home gardens
- Please have construction and demolition waste, tires, batteries, automobile parts, fire extinguishers, motorcycles, charcoal, ash, printed corrugated sheets disposed of by the stores you purchased them from or by waste disposal companies. [These items are not collected by the city.]
- Disposal of refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes driers, air conditioners, and TV sets according to the Home Appliance Recycling Law. [Inquiries about home appliance recycling: Home Appliance Recycling Center TEL: 0120-319640]
